 - Option 1: () One bedroom unit, single occupancy: **\$1,866.67**-- [\$800.00 per month + \$266.67]
 - Option 2: * () One bedroom unit, double occupancy: **\$ 968.34** -- [\$415.00 per month + \$138.34]
 - Option 3: * () Two bedroom unit, with private room: **\$1,400.00**-- [\$600.00 per month + \$200.00]
 - 3. Summer II Session – June 18, 2018 to July 27, 2018** (1 month + 10 days) **Due: May 18, 2018**
 - Option 1: () One bedroom unit, single occupancy **\$1,066.67**-- [\$800.00 per month + \$266.67]
 - Option 2: * () One bedroom unit, double occupancy **\$ 553.34** -- [\$415.00 per month + \$138.34]
 - Option 3: * () Two bedroom unit, with private room **\$ 800.00** -- [\$600.00 per month + \$200.00]

II. Terms and Conditions To Reserve Your Option:

Applicant will submit \$300.00 together with this application and shall pay the rent per the option selected at least 30 days before the term begins. Payments can be made by money order, traveler's

checks, cashier's checks, bank checks or personal checks in U.S. Dollars drawn on U.S. financial institutions payable to "Waiakea Lagoon View Apartments" or "WLV Apts." Payments can be made in cash. **Credit cards or debit cards are not accepted.**

III. Reservations and Cancellations:

A. Consideration:

1. **Applicant hereby tenders \$300.00 payable to WLV along with this application to reserve a space.** Generally, date of receipt determines priority in obtaining the option selected subject to timely rental payment by the deadlines noted herein.

Upon execution and receipt of the rental payment on or before 30 days before the commencement of the rental period, said deposit will be converted to a security deposit to cover damages and loss of personal property, cleaning expenses, failing to pay other charges that are attributed to applicant and cancellation fees.

B. Cancellations:

1. **Applicant agrees that if applicant cancels any time after making the deposit and prior to the commencement of the rental period, applicant will be charged \$50.00.**

2. **Cancellation After the Commence Date When the Term Begins:**

Within 10 days: One month's rent forfeited as and for liquidated damages. Notice must be given at least 1 month prior to departure.

After 10 days: All rental deposits paid in shall become forfeited as and for liquidated damages (unless you find someone to assume your position, subject to WLV's approval of said tenant at their sole discretion).

IV. Estimated Arrival Date and Departure: **Please insert your estimated date and time of arrival:** _____

_____. WLV does provide transportation from Hilo Airport to our location if requested by the new student tenants. Please let us know in advance if you will need a ride. Upon arrival at Hilo Airport, please call Harry at (808) 840-9316 or Marilyn at (808) 937-9260 only after you get your baggage and wait for us at the curbside. We should be there within 10 minutes. This is a one-time courtesy ride offered to our new student tenants.

V. Procedure as to Assignment of Unit:

- A. WLV has sole discretion to assign applicant (or transfer after assignment) to a particular unit. Applicant may request WLV for a transfer to another unit for good cause and subject to the availability.

VI. Rules and Regulations:

- A. House Rules and Regulations will be issued to you upon arrival or see our website at www.wlvapartments.com. Quiet hours are strictly enforced.
- B. UHH Rules and Regulations concerning housing and student discipline including eviction procedures are also applicable to WLV residents. Each applicant is solely responsible to review these rules and regulations provided by UHH. WLV has complete authority to discipline any student for violation of any house rule including the right to evict and acknowledges that the Hawaii Landlord Tenant Code as to eviction and termination and security deposits does not apply.

VII. Transportation Between Apartment Complex and Campus and Shopping Center.

The Hawai'i County currently provides HELE ON bus service for \$1.00 on a limited basis for students (including college students) with a valid student ID, seniors age 60 and over with a valid ID, and disabled people with a Disability Bus Pass. It is \$2.00 for all others. Bus schedules and routes can be found on-line at www.heleonbus.org. (There is also a bus [Keaukaha route] that travels to and from Hilo Airport. The website also has information on the County's subsidized Shared Ride Taxi Program. Taxi coupons can be purchased by mail or in person from the Hawai'i County's Mass Transit Agency. Please check their website for more information.

VIII. What is Included and Excluded in Rent:

- A. **Tenant is responsible for setting up and paying for their own telephone, cable TV and Internet services.** Used TV sets are available for rent for \$10.00 per month or \$35.00 per semester, subject to availability.
- B. Units include, a full size refrigerator, a gas or electric range, a microwave oven, dishes, pots, pans, basic utensils, twin bed (a double bed request is subject to availability on a first come first serve basis), chest of drawers, futon sofa/love seat (or equivalent furniture), dining tables and chairs, study desk with a chair, a

ceiling fan, and other miscellaneous items that may differ in each unit such as book cases, TV stand, end tables, lamps and microwave stands.

- C. **Utilities (except telephone) are included, however, electricity charges is covered up to a maximum of \$50.00 per month for 1 bedroom units that have gas ranges and \$60.00 for units with electric ranges (in Wailoa only) and for all 2 bedroom units. 2 bedroom units in Wailoa with electric ranges will have a \$70.00 maximum.** Since cooking is done mostly by gas and heated water by gas and solar power, one-fourth to one-third of the units go below the amount we pay for electric charges. Pro-rata charges will be assessed for 2 or more occupants. (A copy of the electric bill will be provided when the tenant goes over the maximum allowed.)
- D. Applicant will have to provide his/her own linens, towels, pillow, soap, paper towels, toilet tissue & cleaning supplies, etc.
- E. Telephone hook-up, basic cable TV services and internet access is the tenant's responsibility.
- F. Laundry service. (There are coin operated washers and dryers available on-site.)

IX. Other Rental Options.

An Applicant who elects to come before the start of their rental period or departs after their rental period shall pay the additional rate per day:

- A. Option No. 1: One Bedroom Unit
 - 1. single occupancy \$28.00 per day
 - 2. double occupancy (two sharing one bedroom) \$14.50 per day
- B. Option No. 2: Two Bedroom Unit
 - 1. a private room \$21.00 per day
 - 2. double occupancy \$14.50 per day
